- Submissions for PHO/MGD prefix classes only
- Artwork must be professionally presented for Gallery display
 - Canvas wraps, metal stand out
 - Black frame white matte
 - Display- pedestals (If your work requires special needs please discuss with your instructor)
 - Animation or interactive formats (Flash, HTML5, Javascript, MP4, MP3)
- Artwork must be wired and ready for exhibition
- Missing wires or saw tooth hangers may be rejected
- Artwork with damaged frames may not be accepted
- Artist is responsible for legibility and accuracy of contact information
- Artist is responsible for artwork Pick Up on designated Pick Up date
- Completed identification labels must be firmly attached to the back upper left corner and the front left corner of all 2-D work. 3-D work must also have two labels firmly attached
- Refusal of artwork is at discretion of Gallery Director
- Gallery is not responsible for damage to artwork. Artist is responsible for art insurance
